

COACH OF THE YEAR | TEAM/CLUB OF THE YEAR | SPIRIT OF SPORT (VOLUNTEER/ADMINISTRATION AWARD)

- The period of consideration is January 1, 2020 to December 31, 2020.
- To be eligible for the awards, nominees must be a resident or have been a resident in the Riverine Herald circulation area, however if the nominee has moved out of the Riverine Herald circulation area they must represent a sporting club or individual within the circulation of the Riverine Herald, or if a non-resident, who is currently an active, financial member of the club/individual concerned over a number of years. (This is to be left to the Judge's discretion). Students attending tertiary education are still deemed to reside at family address. This will be left to the discretion of the Judging Committee. However the sporting achievements may occur outside the area.
- Nominations must include a completed official nomination form and attach any relevant information in the current year also detailing paid or voluntary position. Nominations to be addressed to the Sportstar Administrator C/- Riverine Herald, 28 Percy Street, Echuca, 3564. Entries close January 6th, 2021.

COACH OF THE YEAR AWARD

- Finalists will be selected and invited to the Sportstar Awards Dinner with the winner announced on the night.

- This award is to recognize those who work tirelessly to promote and conduct local sporting events and competitions.

- Demonstrated excellence in their role as an official of their chosen sport, excels in all aspects, role model to others, displays immense personal pride.
- Finalists will be selected and invited to the Sportstar Awards Dinner with the winner announced on the night.
